

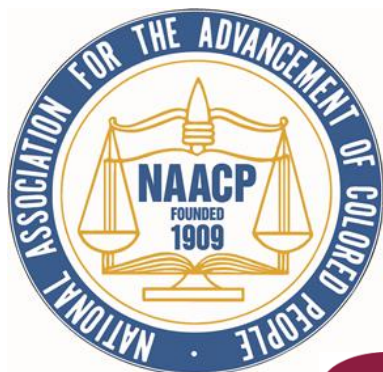
2020 CENSUS

VOTER REGISTRATION

Online Registration

You can register online to vote by going to the Online Voter Registration Website (<https://secure.utah.gov/voterreg/index.html>) and completing the online form. In order to register online, you must have a current Utah Driver's License or ID Card. (You can update your address on your driver's license online before registering to vote by going to the Driver's License Division (<https://dld.utah.gov/>). If you are registering online, you must submit your registration at least 11 days prior to an election to be eligible to vote in that election.

Update Your Registration Address

If you are registered to vote in Salt Lake County and have moved within Salt Lake County, you may update your address by emailing: got-vote@slco.org. Include your name, birthdate, previous address and current address. Once you submit your email with the address update, you will receive a response.
